In follow up to vision screening conducted by the Lions Club or Aaron Henry Optometry earlier this year, some students were recommended for further assessment by an optometrist. If a vision assessment was recommended for your child, I ask that you complete a short survey that will be emailed out on Monday 11/8/25. The information provided will be used by the school to explore community sponsorship opportunities that may assist families with the costs of the eye exams and if needed, glasses.
