AIS/Problem Solvers - Stage 3

Our Stage 3 students are leading the way in making sports more inclusive within our community! Last week, we had the incredible opportunity to welcome Olympic Silver Medalist Olivia Price to our school. Olivia, an Olympic Sailing champion, ran an inspiring workshop as part of the Australian Institute of Sport's Problem Solvers Program, which is designed to engage students in innovative design thinking and problem-solving.

This free program, aligned with the Australian curriculum and supported by HART Sport, brings elite athletes into primary school classrooms to spark creativity and critical thinking. Through sport-related challenges, students collaborate in groups to tackle real-world problems using specially designed resources from the AIS. The experience culminates in presentations to the athletes, allowing our students to showcase their solutions and creativity. We are proud of our Stage 3 students for their enthusiasm and commitment to making sports accessible for everyone!


