#### Creative Poetry Workshop with Story Factory Digital - Stage 2

Our Stage 2 classes studying poetry are excited to take part next week, in an engaging online workshop with Story Factory Digital. This organisation partners with schools across Australia to inspire young people in creative writing through fun, high-quality activities that build confidence and enhance literacy skills. During the workshop, students will explore the playful and humorous short poem 'Fried Lies' by Harry Laing, an acclaimed children's writer, poet, and comedic performer from the Southern Tablelands of NSW. Through this experience, students will practice using descriptive imagery and rhyme as they craft their unique versions of Fried Lies, sparking creativity and a love for poetry.
