Are you curious about the ethics program in NSW public schools? Wondering how these classes help children develop critical thinking and respectful discussion skills?

Who can take ethics classes?

Right now, at Beaumont Hills PS, ethics classes are available to students in Years 3/4. The class is facilitated by a volunteer ethics teacher.

To offer the program for students in other years, we need 3 volunteers.

When do classes run?

Ethics lessons (30 min) take place on Wednesdays from 9:25 am.

Could you be an ethics teacher?

You don't need teaching experience - just an interest in listening to children and helping them think for themselves. Volunteers receive full training and ongoing support.

You can be an ethics teacher if:

- · You're curious about what children think and open to learning
- You're comfortable following a lesson script to guide discussions
- You can stay neutral and encourage children to think independently
- You're available to take a class every Wednesday morning during the school terms
- You can complete our free training and pass background checks

Volunteering as an ethics teacher is a rewarding way to support your child's school, build new skills, and connect with a community of like-minded volunteers.

Dear Parents.

Welcome back, and a very special welcome to our new students and parents! We are looking forward to another great year of making music. Correspondence will be via email: please ensure TSA has your current email address and check your junk/spam folder for communications.

NEW BEGINNERS (those learning an instrument for the first time in 2024)

There are two components to the Band Program: group lessons and a full band rehearsal both held on the same day. **Please note, all group lessons take place** <u>after school.</u> Your band director will email you with further details.

Group lessons: Start Thursday 8 February (a timetable will be emailed to parents by your band director)

What to bring: Instrument if already purchased; items ordered through TSA will be

distributed in the first lesson.

• Full Band Rehearsal: Beginners will not be required at band rehearsal until Term 2. Training Band

rehearsals will be on Thursdays at lunchtime.

The first lesson will focus on showing new students how to set-up and care for their instruments.

EXISTING BAND STUDENTS (those who already learned an instrument in 2023)

Full band rehearsal: Starts Thursday 8 February at 2:00-2:45pm in the Hall

Group lessons: Start Thursday 8 February (after school). A timetable will be emailed to parents.

What to bring: Instrument & pencil, Accent on Achievement book and band folder.

The first lesson will focus on finalising grouping and assessing how continuing students have progressed across the summer holiday break.

IMPORTANT ITEMS

Fees – In 2024, band and group tuition fees will be \$220 per term plus \$10 resource levy. TSA will email invoices/process direct debits at the beginning of each school term and needs to be finalised within 2 weeks of issue or late fees will apply.

Absence from Band – if your child will be absent from band or lessons please notify the band director. In particular, absences outside of school hours must be communicated clearly so we can confirm your child is safe and accounted for.

Creative Kids Vouchers – TSA is a registered provider and families with Creative Kids Vouchers can apply them to term fees by entering voucher details via the TSA website here: https://teachingservices.com.au/creative-kids/.

Exiting the Band Program – TSA requires notice by the end of any term if your child wishes to exit from the program in the next term.
