BOOK WEEK PARADE PYJAMA DAY

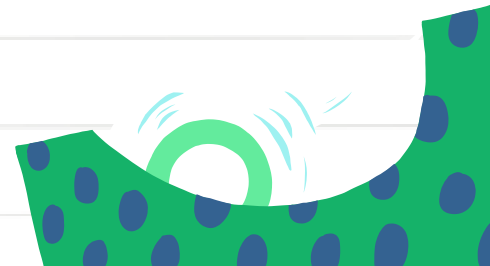

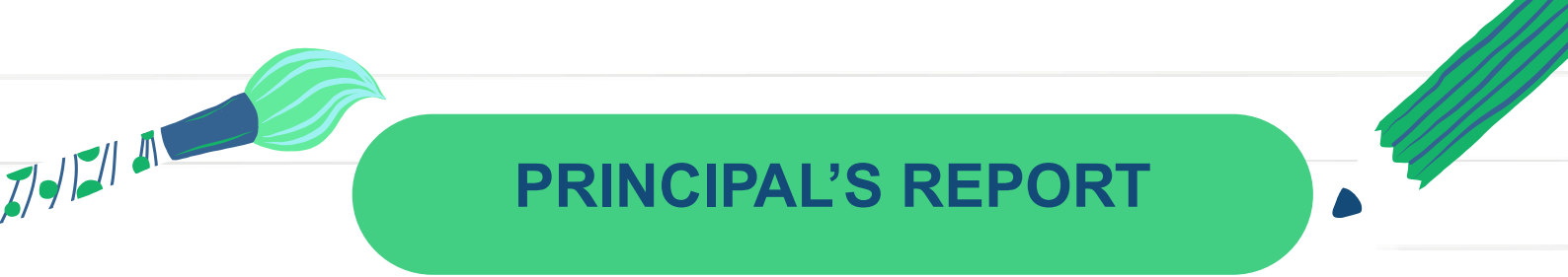
CELEBRATING OUR SASS STAFF: THE HEART OF OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

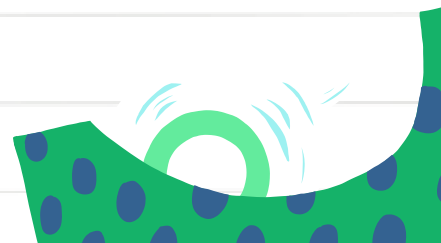
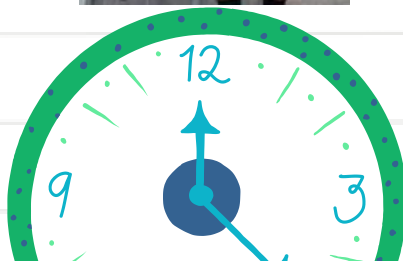
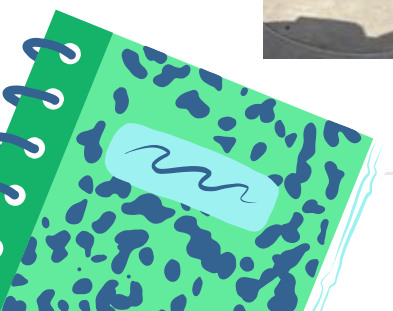
CASTLE HILLS PSSA ZONE ATHLETICS CARNIVAL
