



Since this was an open competition, there were participants from many countries. Diona can proudly be regarded as the top Australian skater in her category.

As skating conditions in Australia are quite limited, with fewer ice rinks and professional coaches, Diona often travels back to China for additional training. On November 1, she will also be competing again in the NSW competition, where she was the champion last year. Congratulations, Diona! We look forward to hearing about your future success and seeing you whizz around the ice rink at a future Winter Olympics!

















