


### FIND AN ALTERNATE DROP OFF/PICK UP LOCATION

Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September will be a busy day at the school as we prepare for the main event. We will have the rides delivered and set up on Mary St, the Food tents and equipment arriving, as well as a couple of other key deliveries.

We ask all families to avoid dropping off and parking in Mary St for the entire day. This means the deliveries will be able to get in and out as quickly as possible; minimising the interruption to the school day.

Our ride vendor is bringing snow cones and fairy floss (they will not accept Fair tickets. Card only).


### THE MARKET STALLS WILL BE THE PLACE TO BE!
