Highlights included our Advanced Strings serenading the audience with the Finale from Serenade No. 9 by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, alongside *The General's Order* — an ancient Chinese-themed piece arranged by Albert Wang.



Our Concert Band enchanted the crowd with *Minka's Sleigh Ride*, setting the perfect festive mood, and concluded with a powerful performance of *Golden* from the popular K-Pop series Demon Hunter.
