#### From the Principal

**Vision Screening** - A huge thankyou to Tom and the team at George & Matilda Eyecare for completing our vision screening last week. Reports have gone home to parents and the results were surprising. The effects of screen time are really being seen from a very young age.

Following analysis of the data, we wish to share some key findings of those who participated:

- 3 in 5 children screened were found to have an undetected vision problem, which was above the expected 1 in 5
- The most common vision issue detected relates to refractive error, with half of all children screened requiring further investigation of their distance prescription
- Distance vision and colour vision was impacted in 1 in 5 students
- 1 in 5 children had two vision problems, with 1 in 10 having three vision problems.

Refractive error requires further investigation in 75% of students screened. This includes:

- Hyperopia (far-sightedness) Where these children may lose visual focus or have trouble concentrating for extended periods of time
- Myopia (short-sightedness) An epidemic projected to affect 50% of the world's population by 2050, exacerbated by long periods of digital screen use and limited time spent outdoors. It is important to detect myopia early to slow down how quickly a child's prescription changes over time, and to reduce risk of future eye health problems linked to myopia.
- Amblyopia (lazy eye) Where one eye has weaker vision than the other, usually due to a strong distance prescription requiring correction. This can be reversed by age 10 if treated correctly.

We encourage you to book a bulk-billed appointment to discuss and investigate your child's vision further. Appointments may be made by calling our clinic on (02) 6962 5643.

If your child was away on the day of screening and you completed the questionnaire; they have a list at the eyecare centre and you can ring to make an appointment to complete the screening at a time that suits you.
