Presentation 2026 - This year we will be having 2 presentation day ceremonies. There will be a low-key day presentation at school starting at 2pm on Thursday 11th December. At this assembly we will be presenting 95%+ attendance, bug chat, choir and special awards. The senior choir will also perform. You will receive a notification if your child will be receiving one of these awards. The main presentation ceremony will be held at the Griffith Regional Theatre on Thursday 11th December starting at 6pm sharp. This is a ticketed event, and tickets went on sale today. There is no limit to the number of tickets per family this year. Tickets are only available from the front office - you can send the money in with your child and the number of seats required and the staff will select your tickets for you. Alternatively, you can come into the office anytime from 8.30am - 3.30pm to select your seating and pay via EFTPOS.



End of Year Class Parties - On Wednesday 17th December all eligible students will be invited to attend their end of year celebrations. As these are not educationally based excursions, students whose behaviour has been under review may not be allowed to attend. K-2 will be going to the movies, Year 3-5 will be going to the pool and having pizza and Year 6 will be going to Lake Talbot. Once final arrangements have been made the excursion details will be sent home via Compass.
