

ACCESS TO THE LATEST TECHNOLOGY

All learning areas at Belrose PS have the installation of Commboxes (Touch screen digital panels). Our school does not have to rely on parents purchasing BYOD devices, ipads, laptops and desktops. To support our strategic direction for active learning approaches for student engagement, each classroom has ipads, chrome books, desktops and laptops. These devices have supported our pedagogical shift in how we teach and engage student learning. Access to technology can:

- -accelerate learning as students access information at a faster pace
- -support teacher differentiation
- -engage students further with key elements of dialogue and teamwork
- -provide opportunities for computational thinking

We are putting steps in place to provide our students with the knowledge, skills and capabilities to lead and flourish in tomorrow's world.

SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS

Schedule of Payment Accounts will be emailed home in the coming weeks. Please email or call the school if you are experiencing financial constraints at the moment. All discussions are confidential. The subscriptions provide your child with an annual subscription for access at home and at school to **Mathletics**, **Seesaw and Reading Eggs**. Usernames and passwords are printed out for the students. **Worldbook** online can be accessed with Username: Belrose and Passwords: Belrose The Worldbook online is presented at the students' level of understanding. We have an advanced subscription of 'Early World and Learning' and 'Timelines'. The school uses a payment system called Schoolbytes. This systems allows you to select which items you are paying for as well as part-payments over time.

Back to School NSW Vouchers

- Vouchers are valid up until 30 June 2023.
- Each voucher can be used separately, or multiple vouchers can be used in the same purchase.
- Each voucher can only be redeemed once. If the transaction is less than the total value of the voucher, the remaining balance is forfeited and cannot be used in another transaction, e.g. if the transaction is \$96.50 and two vouchers, totalling \$100 are redeemed, the remaining \$3.50 is forfeited.
- No refunds can be claimed for products redeemed with a voucher.

How to use your vouchers

- 1. Present the voucher (paper copy or voucher on your device) in person to the school office between **9 and 12**, **Monday to Friday from Monday 20 February**. Please note we cannot accept emailed vouchers.
- 2. We will need you to wait while we process the vouchers. It could take a few minutes. Thank you for your patience!


