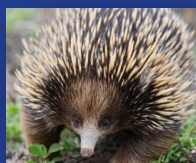

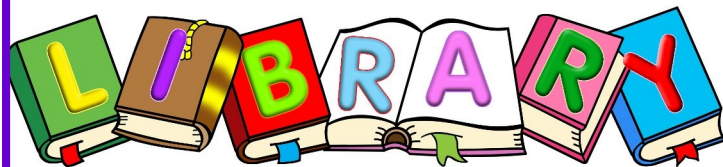

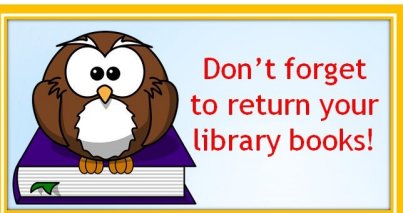
Yellow Learning Group

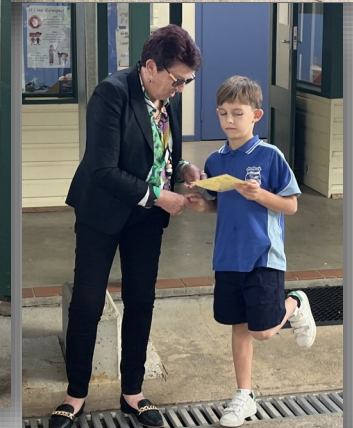

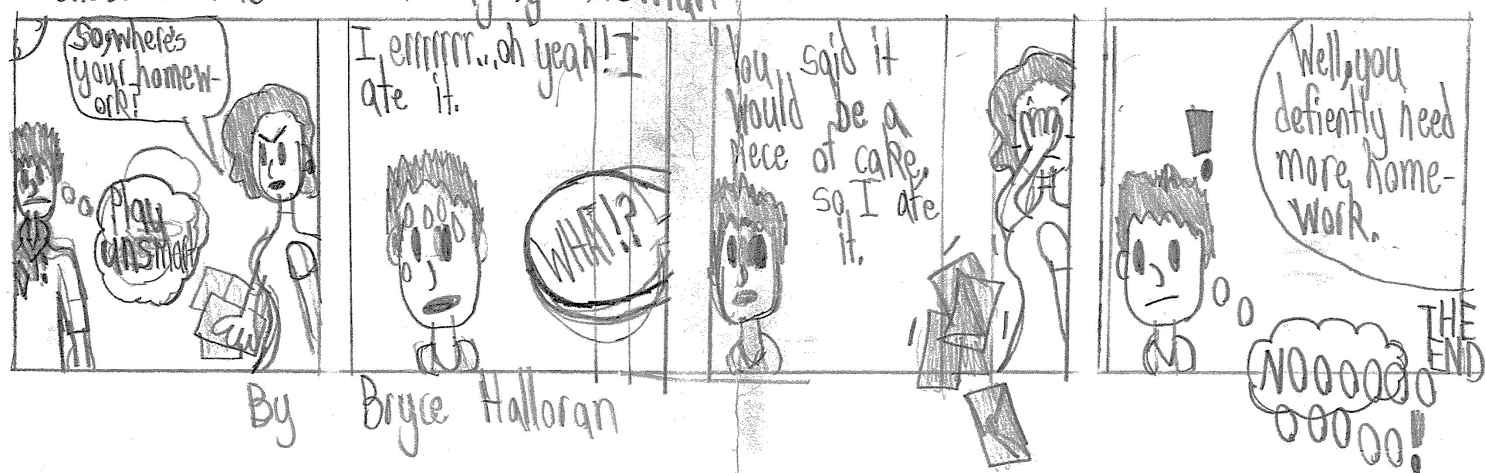
