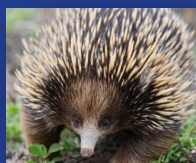

School Reports: Information for families – Kindergarten to Year 6

From Term 2 2025, we're introducing updated school reports.

The new format has been developed by the NSW Department of Education in response to feedback from parents and

educators to make reports easier to read and understand.

Your child's report will still show their progress across all subject areas.

Teacher comments will appear in English, mathematics and the general comment section, in line with department policy.

The general comment for Kindergarten also covers all other key learning areas including, creative arts, HSIE, PDHPE, and science and technology.

A new achievement scale and descriptions are included to provide a clearer picture of your child's progress.

Parent-teacher interviews remain an important way to discuss your child's progress and achievement in more detail. We will be holding these early next term.

We welcome your feedback or questions about the new report format.

End of Day Routine

As part of our commitment to continuously improving our practices, we are enhancing our end-of-day routine procedures.

We kindly ask each family to complete the attached form regarding your child's end-of-day routines. This form will also be available on School Bytes for your convenience.

Once you submit the form, you will only need to reach out to the school if there are any changes to the routine you have provided.

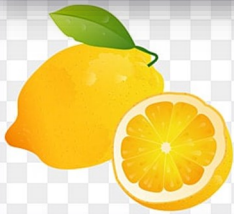
Thank you for your cooperation and support as we work together to ensure a smooth end-of-day process for all our students.

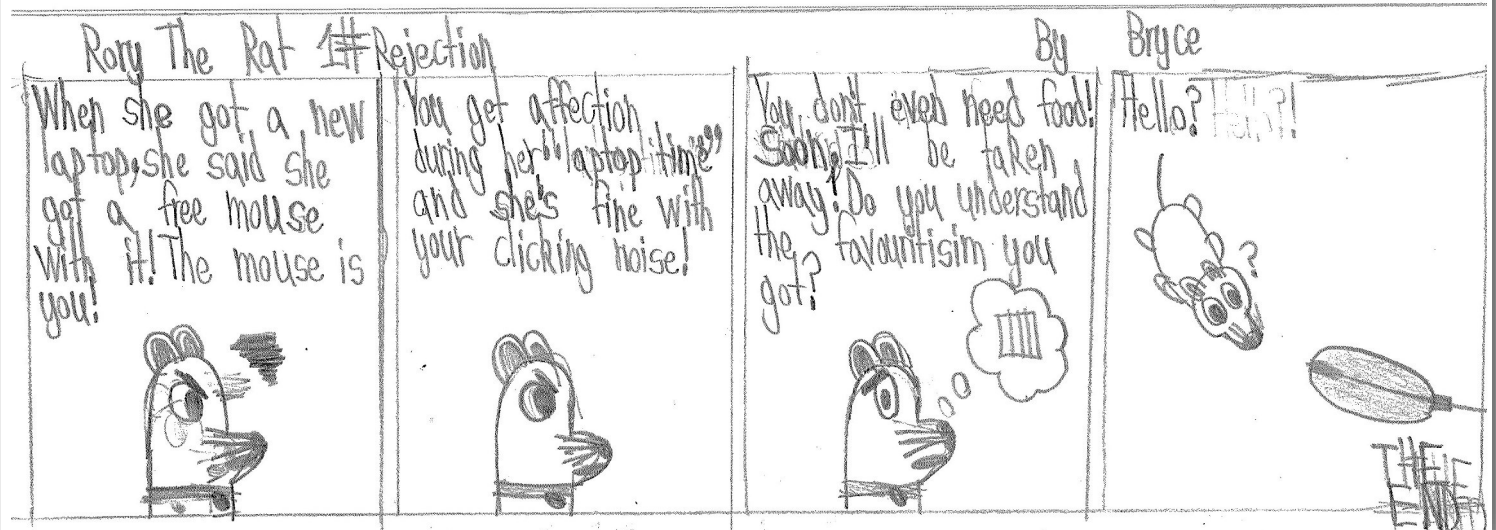


Engineers Without Borders
