#### **Parking Safety**

Please note that parents and carers will no longer be able to access the staff car park at any time for student drop-off or pick-up.

Student safety is our priority, while also ensuring access for emergency vehicles, Support Unit transport vehicles, and staff parking.

Families are reminded to follow all road signage and parking rules outside the school to support safe traffic flow.

This also includes not parking across local driveways and the skip bin driveway. Council parking rangers have been engaged to monitor the school during peak morning and afternoon periods.

A reminder that parents may use the Darling Street car park area for safer access to the school.
