PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

CAPITAL WORKS

I am very pleased to inform the community that we are having the student toilet block renovated starting in the school holidays. The block will be completely stripped on the inside with some changes to the floor plan. The hazardous work is planned to happen over the holidays, and renovation will be finalised in the early weeks of term 2. Temporary ablution blocks will be used for students during the early weeks of term 2 as the work is finalised.

WASTE AUDIT

Miss Smith's 3/4S barra barra class is working with Bournda EEC this year. They are participating in the "Let's Get it Sorted" program. Students are learning about and implementing ways to reduce the amount of waste that schools send to landfills. Barra barra class will be the change makers at our school. The program is fully funded by Bega Valley Shire Council and is run by Bournda Environmental Education Centre.

Students with Lara and Jules (teachers from Bournda EEC) have begun by conducting a waste audit of the playground bins and developed an action plan. They are now beginning to implement their action plan, which will lead to educating the school community. They have some exciting plans in place that will be shared with the entire school soon.

Watch this space! Yesterday, students spent the day touring the Central Waste Facility and the Merimbula Organics Processing Facility. At the conclusion of the program, a final waste audit will be conducted to see a reduction in waste that goes to landfill.

YEAR 6 TO 7 EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

All Year 6 families have been sent a link via School Bytes to enrol your child in Year 7 for 2026, you will need to complete an expression of interest for Year 6 to Year 7 transition. The expression of interest (EOI) lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7.

This is a reminder that all online expressions of interest need to be completed by this Friday, 28 March 2025.

After you submit an EOI and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a high school.

If your child will not be attending a NSW Government high school next year, please let us know by completing a Placement Not Required form.

If you are unsure whether they will be attending a NSW Government school (you've applied for a private school, or you are moving interstate), we ask that you still complete an EOI and follow up with your school once a decision has been made.

The online process will guide you through your options and collect the information required to make the process as smooth as possible.

For parents/carers who are not able to complete an application online, a paper EOI form can be collected from the school office.

K-2 AFL SKILLS DAY

On Thursday, 10 April, our K-2 students will participate in an AFL skills morning. They will participate in rotations led by our senior students with the support of our local AFL development officers. There is no cost for this event, and it will be held on our school's bottom oval.

EASTER HAT PARADE

All Kindergarten to Year 6 students will make a hat for our Easter Hat Parade at school. All resources will be provided. The parade will be held on Friday, 11 April at 11:00am under the COLA. Families are most welcome to attend to watch the parade.

SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY

The distances for the races are as follows:
