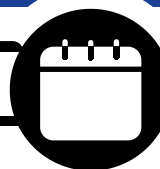
A big thank you to our Stage 3 staff for organising the day and supporting our students.

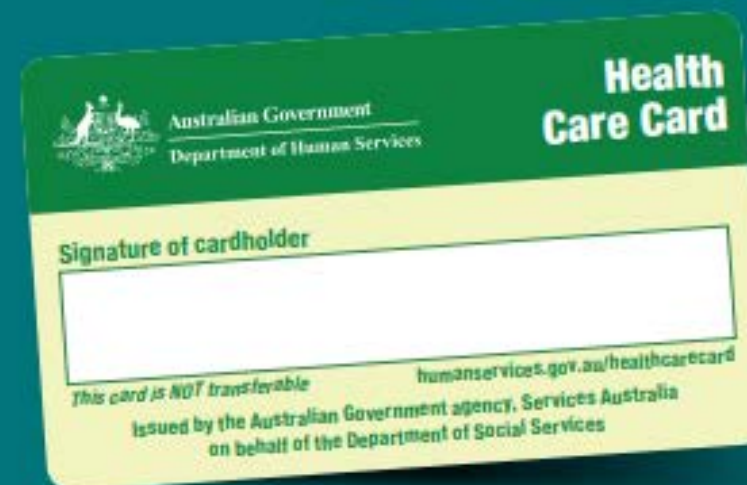
