Bournda and Zoomobile

Last Monday, our Kindergarten to Year 2 students enjoyed an exciting and educational day filled with outdoor adventures and close encounters with native Australian wildlife as part of our Bournda activities. The highlight of the day was a special visit from the Zoomobile, which brought a fascinating array of animals right to our school. The children had the incredible opportunity to meet and learn about a diamond python, a blue-tongued lizard, a ring-tailed possum, a tortoise, and a shingle-back lizard.

Our students showed great curiosity, respect, and enthusiasm throughout the experience, impressing not only their teachers but also the Bournda staff who facilitated the day. It was wonderful to hear such positive feedback about how engaged and well-behaved our young learners were during the activities.

This hands-on experience is invaluable in helping our students develop a deeper appreciation and understanding of Australia's unique wildlife and natural environment. We look forward to more opportunities like this to inspire our students' love of nature and learning.

Year 6 Camp at The Crossing, Bermagui

Our Year 6 students had an unforgettable adventure at The Crossing in Bermagui last week! They fully embraced the land sustainability and education program, diving into hands-on activities that taught them both responsibility and teamwork.

Students prepped and cooked their own dinner, fed the chickens, planted seeds, and even stacked wood for the campfire cooking. They canoed down the river to plant trees along the riverbank and ended the night with a delicious meal followed by marshmallow roasting around the campfire.

Sleeping in old train carriages (with some very interesting toilets!) was an experience in itself. On Friday morning, they were up early to clean the site before tackling a tricky bush log maze—challenging, but lots of fun!

The biggest test came with the 6-7 km trek back to school through bush, rainforest, water crossings, and even mountain climbs. Along the way, they stopped to learn about the environment and explore the wonders of the bush. There were a few complaints along the trail, but the cheers of relief at the finish line said it all!

The students had such an amazing time that many begged to stay longer. A huge thank you to our dedicated teachers who gave their time and energy to make this experience so memorable.






