- Be aware of and give way to pedestrians on the footpath if riding or scooting


Website Revamp


Children's Day - 4th August 2024


WEEK 7 - NAIDOC WEEK



Accessories - Nail polish or false nails are not permitted to be worn at school. Hair that touches the shoulder must be pulled back. Small hair accessories are permitted in the school colours of purple, yellow and black.
