

Today's focus: Spelling (Making plurals)

PLURAL: a form of a word that indicates more than one person, animal, thing, or idea

Students at BPS have been learning about the spelling conventions we use in English to make words into plurals. For students in Kindergarten and Stage 1, this has been new learning, whereas in Stage 2 and 3, students are reviewing already taught conventions to ensure they use them consistently and accurately in their own writing.

Kindergarten

Adding 's' to a base word to make a plural with no change to the base word





Key Language *BASE WORD*

the simplest form of a word **SUFFIX**

a group of letters added to the end of a base word to change its meaning

Years 1-6

- Use 'es' plural for words ending in ch, sh, ss, or x:
- Use 'ies' rule for words ending in y: baby-babies.
- Use the exception if base word ends in a voweland 'y' just add s: toys, monkeys.
- Use 'ves' rule for words ending in f: calf-calves.
- Use rule for nouns ending in o

 sometimes -s or -es is used:
 hero-heroes, radio-radios.

Common Misconceptions

We often see confusion between making a plural (one car becomes two cars) and using an 's' to show belonging (the teacher's car). No apostrophes are used in making plurals.

Alien Drawing
Engage with your attitude of curiosity and imagine what an alien would look like if they came and visited Earth. Draw a picture of the alien, what colour are they? How many eyes do they have?

Stage 2

Alien Öbject
Let's practise curiosity by pretending that you're an alien on this planet for the first time! Pick an object in your room and pretend that you have never seen it before. Write a detailed description of it for your alien friends back home. What does it look like?

Feel like? What shape and colour is it?

Stage 3 What If?

One way of practising curiosity is asking lots of questions and trying to see things from different perspectives. Engage with your attitude of curiosity and come up with 5 "what if" questions about the world. For example "what if the trees were made of chocolate?" Be as creative as you can.
