Our K–1 students had a fantastic time taking part in modified athletics events and games, enjoying a fun-filled day of participation and teamwork.

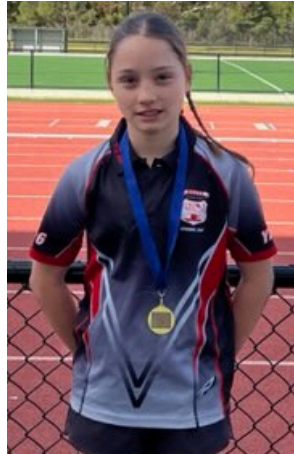
