# It's Term 4 already!!

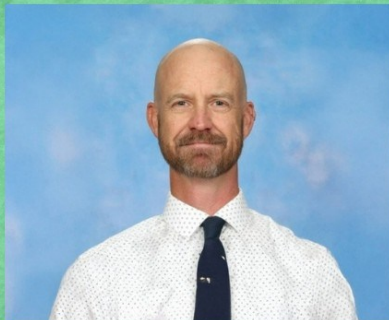
I would like to welcome to Blayney High School two new staff members.
