Roles and Responsibilities

The following role descriptions are intended as a guide only. Each role may vary depending on the individual that fulfills the position and the requirements of the committee at the time.

President

The president is responsible for overseeing the P&C and any associated committees. The president liaises with the P&C association and Principal over any P&C matter. The president is responsible for –

- The successful functioning of the P&C
- Welcoming new members, fostering inclusion and supporting volunteers
- Chair meetings
- Ensures the P&C takes part in decision making within the school
- Be the P&C spokesperson when needed
- Signatory on bank accounts
- Work with canteen staff to ensure smooth operations
- Automatic member of any sub committees that may be required
- Participates in school finance meetings regarding budget and upcoming spending

Vice President

The vice president in the absence of the president presides over meetings. The vice president supports the role of the president and may be required to –

- Chair meetings in the absence of the president
- Represent the president when they are not available
- Support the president, secretary and treasurer as needed
- May be a signatory on bank accounts

Secretary

The secretary attends meeting and keeps a record of all business conducted. They are responsible for –

- Taking minutes at meetings and distributing as necessary
- Prepare agendas and announce meetings
- Ensure all P&C staff, executive members and volunteers have WWCC as required
- Dealing with administrative tasks
- Tabling correspondence received and outgoing
- Signatory on bank accounts

Treasurer

The treasurer maintains all aspects of the finances of the P&C. They must present statements for meetings and records for auditing each year. The role of the treasurer is –

- Accounting of all funds and assets of the P&C
- Ensure compliance with financial accountability requirements
- Signatory of bank accounts
- Financial reporting at meetings
- Oversee wages and entitlements of P&C Canteen Staff following correct award (knowledge of tax, superannuation, long service leave helpful)
- Pay accounts and issue invoices as necessary (for P&C, Canteen and uniform shop)
- Work within Xero to complete financial records and reconcile accounts
- Liaise with accountant for BAS reporting
- Keep all financial records stored appropriately

Executive Member

- Take part in meetings and decisions
- Assist other committee members as required

Uniform Coordinator

The uniform coordinator is responsible for the running of the uniform shop. Their role is –

- Order stock as required
- Perform stock takes when needed
- Price stock
- Maintain order forms
- Check online deposits and orders regularly and dispatch clothing as needed
- Report to P&C meetings
- Coordinate the uniform orders and sales at the Year 6 transition day in Term 4
- Be the main point of contact for the school in relation to uniform shop

All of these positions work closely with each other for the best possible outcome for our school, staff and students.
