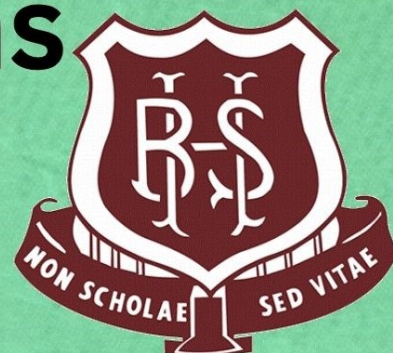


IT'S ALL ABOUT COMMUNITY

THE MORNING TEA RAISED OVER \$1300 FOR THE CANCER COUNCIL.

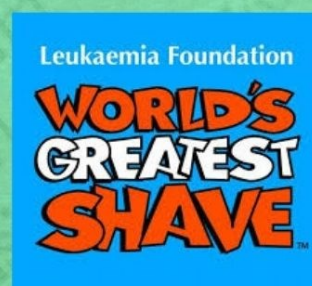
Congratulations and thank you Ms Coughlan for such a wonderful school and community event.
