Dear Parents/Carers of Bonalbo Central School,

In 2025, we are fortunate to have Occupational Therapy (OT) students in our school on Mondays and Tuesdays. For the next two terms, Chloe and Jorja will be with us.

The OT students will be supported by Sarah Miles (Clinical Educator) from the University Centre for Rural Health (UCRH). Sarah and the students will work with our Learning Support team and teachers to support children's well-being and participation in school activities.

Some things they may be able to support children with include:

- Attention and focus
- Self-regulation and behaviour
- Self-care tasks
- Movement skills
- Social skills.

The OT students will be available to support within classrooms and can also provide oneon-one support and assessment to children who do not have existing funding for therapy.
