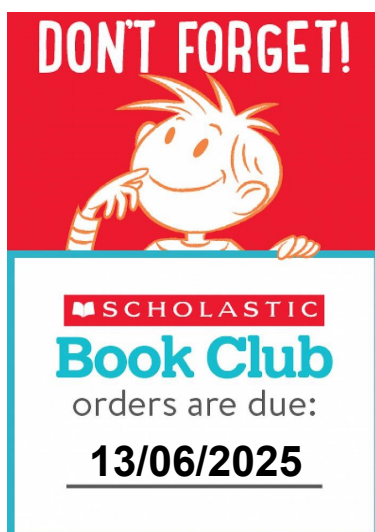
Scholastic Book Club Issue 4

Your donations are greatly appreciated.

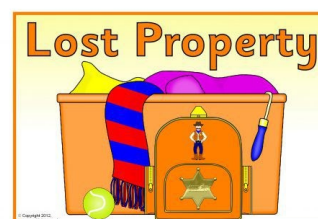
Lost Property
