We wish a very happy birthday to Izzy and Winnie! We hope you both had a wonderful day filled with celebration and joy.



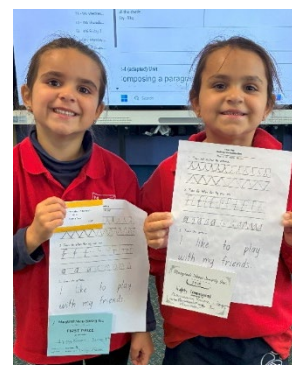
## Tennis Lessons
