What a busy term it has been so far! Time is flying by, and we've already packed so many wonderful experiences into these weeks.

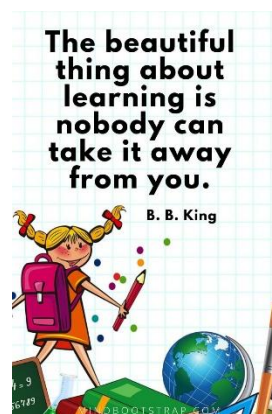

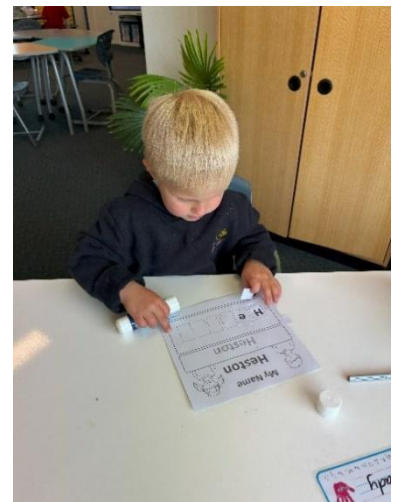
