
WEBSITE UPGRADE:

Parking Rules in School Zones

- Allow enough time to get your child to the school gate safely and without rushing.
- Always observe the parking signs outside the school.
 They are designed to keep children safe.
- Never park illegally in a driveway on or near a school crossing, or in a bus bay.
- Never double park. Double parking blocks the vision for other drivers, forcing children onto the road and obstructs the flow of traffic.
- Park a few streets away and walk your children to school. This is also good for teaching your children road safety skills.



- Always slow down to 40km/h
- Set down your child on the school side of the road
- Park only where parking is permitted
- Never call out to your child from across the road.





Hold my hand

Children up to 8 years old should hold an adult's hand in the car park, on the footpath and when crossing the road. Children up to 10 years old should hold an adult's hand when crossing the road.
