Dear Parents and Carers,

The NSW Department of Education is providing students in Years 5–12 with access to **NSWEduChat**, a generative artificial intelligence (AI) tool developed and owned by the department.

About NSWEduChat

NSWEduChat is designed for educational use within a safe and secure environment. It uses text only and cannot produce images, videos or music. The tool encourages students to think critically by asking open-ended questions rather than supplying full answers. All data entered into NSWEduChat remains within the Department of Education's systems.

Access for students

- Students in **Years 9–12** have had access from **Monday, 3 November 2025**.
- Students in **Years 5–8** will have access from **Monday, 17 November 2025**.

Students can log in to NSWEduChat using their Department of Education credentials via:

- the student portal: <https://portal.education.nsw.gov.au>, or
- directly at: <https://chat.education.nsw.gov.au>.

Access is for the individual student who is logged in.

Use of NSWEduChat

The use of NSWEduChat by staff and students is **optional**. Schools may allow students to use it for classwork, homework or assessment tasks. If students use NSWEduChat when completing assignments, they should inform their teacher about how it was used (for example, for summarising notes or generating ideas).

Student induction and privacy information

All students in Years 5–12 will participate in a short induction session on the safe use of NSWEduChat.
