What to Bring

Students must bring enough food, snacks, and water every day to cover the length of time we are at the venue. Children can bring a small quiet game (E.G. Uno, colouring in) and a roll-on deodorant. They should have hair supplies in case their hair needs to be re-done and their show makeup for touch ups in their bag. This can be carried in a small backpack or bag. There are fill up water points inside Qudos that children can use to refill their plastic drink bottles. Only plastic drink bottles are allowed in the venues. NO METAL OR GLASS. All bags will be checked by security entering the venue.

For Friday and Saturday dinner:

For Friday dinner, Mrs Vella and Mrs Antonelli will walk the students over to the take away shops near Qudos. There are McDonalds, Subway and Oporto available to purchase food from. Please supply your child with some money to cover a dinner meal on the Friday.

On the Saturday, students may be collected between 3:45pm and 4:00pm by their parent or guardian from Tower 10 after the first performance. You will be able to explore "Spec Fest" with them till 6pm or take them to get a dinner meal. If you are unable to collect your child for this two hour break Mrs Vella and Mrs Antonelli will supervise them within the Spec Fest area. They will need some money to purchase a dinner meal from the food trucks in the Spec Fest Area.

We will meet you back at Tower 10 at 6pm to collect your child for the 7pm performance.

What is Spec Fest?

SpecFest is the ultimate outdoor entertainment hub with great food, activities and chill-out zones for the whole family to enjoy. It is located in front of Qudos Bank Arena on Friday 28th and Saturday 29th November in the break times between Schools Spectacular shows. 60 MINUTE GRACE PERIOD PARKING IN P1:

Following the Friday and Saturday evening performances, parents are eligible for a 60-minute fee-free grace period in P1 for student collection.

Starts 30 minutes before the show ends.

Extends 60 minutes from car park entry.

Parents should arrive just before the show ends to make full use of the grace period.


IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT FREE 1 HOUR PARKING

➡ RAILWAY STATION — Patrons to use the main exit at Olympic Park Train Station, follow the pedestrian footpath access to Showground Road, continue along the pedestrian footpath access to Olympic Boulevard, cross Olympic Boulevard, turn right and continue straight along forecourt to Qudos Bank Arena.

Walking time to Venue: 10-15 minutes | Walking Distance to Venue: Approximately 700m

Costume, Hair, and Makeup

On Monday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday it is expected that students wear their black School spec shirt and pants/shorts to each rehearsal or performance.

On Thursday, Friday and Saturday student are expected to arrive having full performance hair and makeup completed.

Students dance costumes will be kept by Mrs Antonelli and Mrs Vella during show week to avoid misplacement.

It is recommended that students bring hair and makeup essentials in their bag for each Dress Rehearsal and Performance to touch up or redo if required.

WHAT TO WEAR

Students arrive in their Schools Spectacular black T-Shirt with comfortable pants or shorts. Beige crop tops/bras and underwear are required to avoid being seen through the costume. No cross/rider backs for crop tops/bras as these will be seen and they need to be hidden. Thin straps are preferable.

A High bun. It is recommended the hair is moussed or gelled, so it stays neat and tidy for a long period of time. Please see photo for a reference of position.
