Lilah, Banjo and Marcus are off to Warrambui for 3 days of creativity, connection and confidence building on Monday.



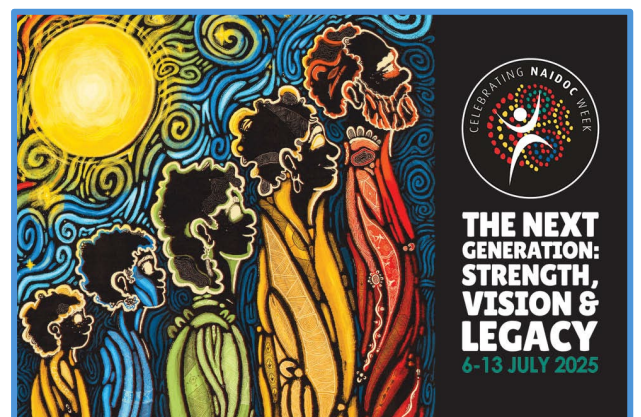
Life Education
