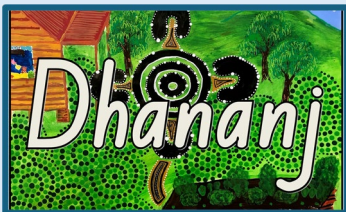

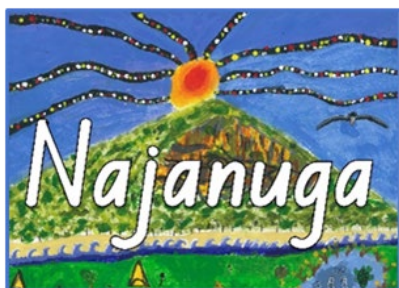
Creative Arts Camp

Congratulations Evie Jay

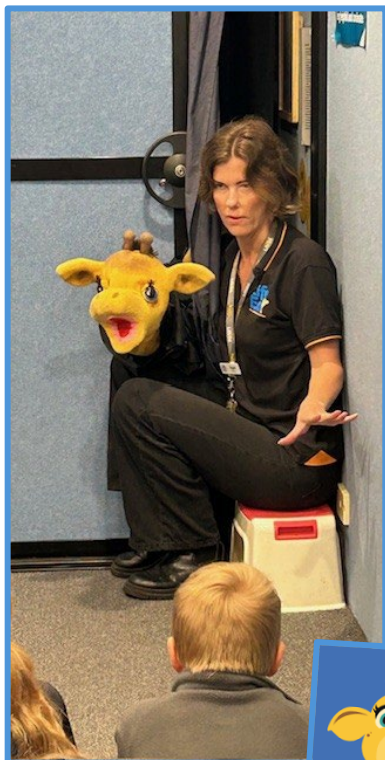

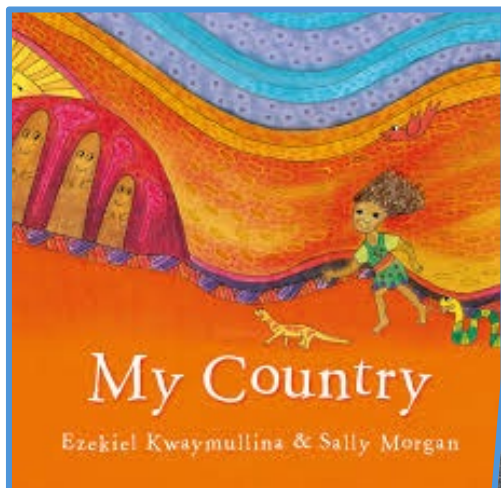


Healthy Harold

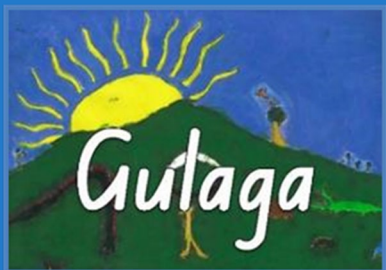
