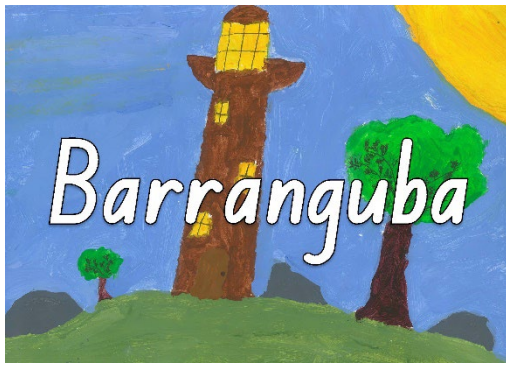
In Technology, the students have been using Bee Bots to learn about coding.

Our science unit for this term is ***Earth in the Solar System.*** This week we investigated how the sun's position affects the length of shadows.

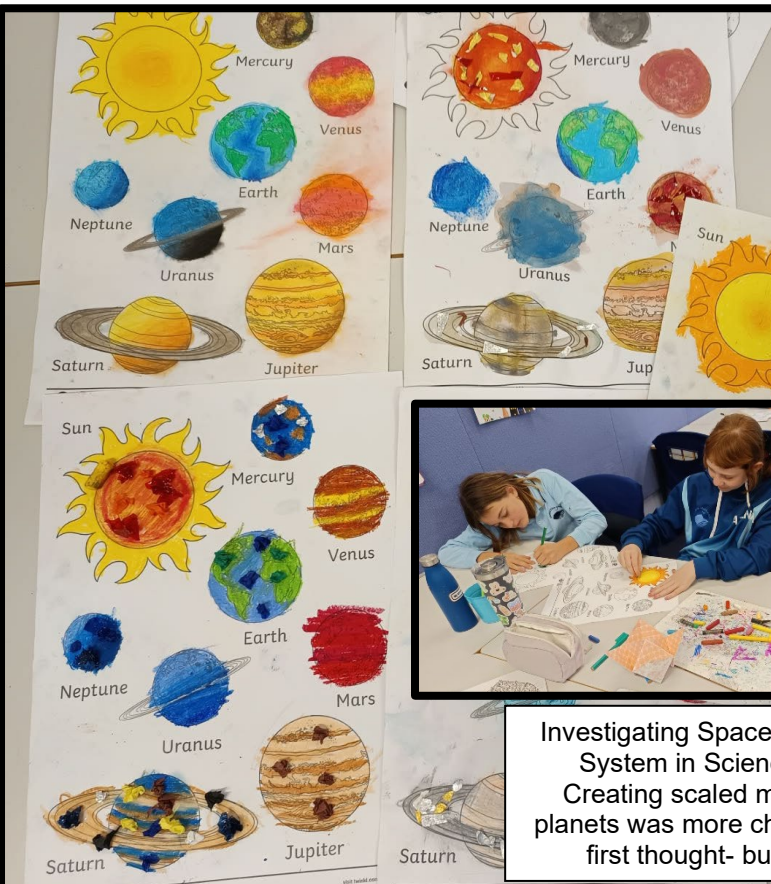


Stage 2 have been exploring drumming and switching between time signatures in music lessons.
