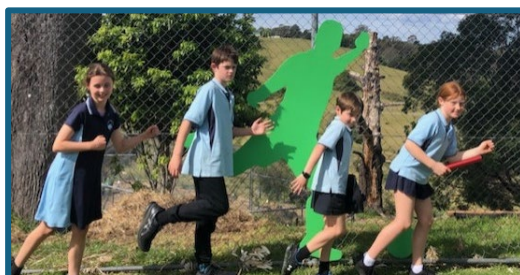

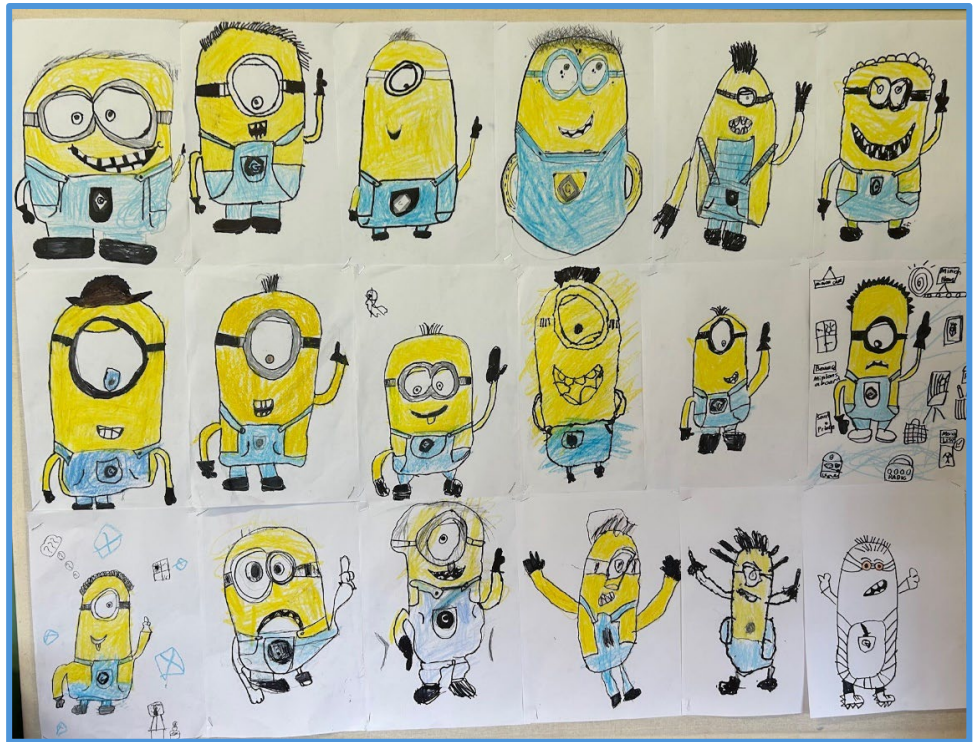
Frida is a valued helper each morning at Breakfast Club and she has beautiful manners - always!

Dance Party Fitness this week!



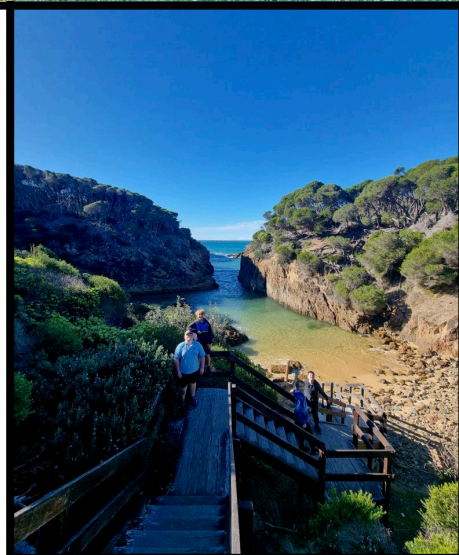

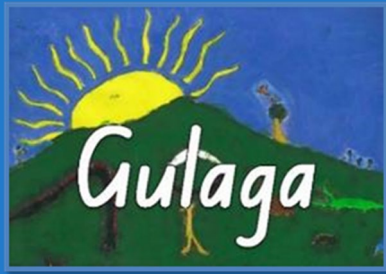
