It is always a pleasure collaborating with parents about the learning journey of their children. Thank you for giving us that opportunity during parent teacher interviews this week.

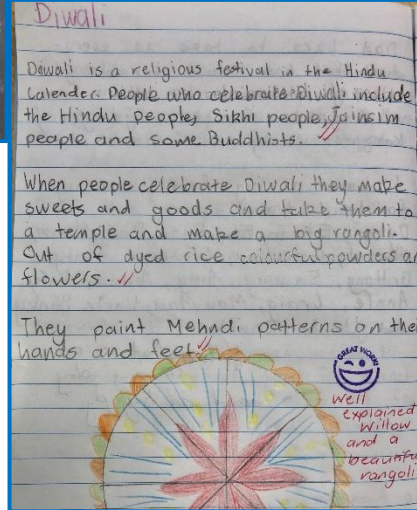
Proud Principal Moment...
