How exciting!!

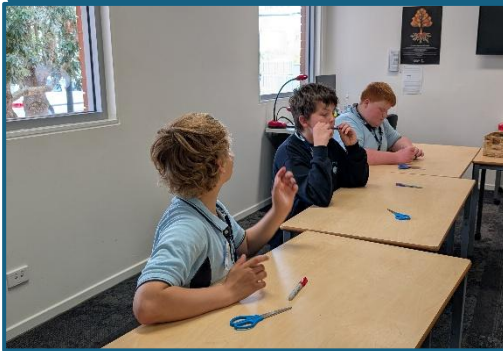
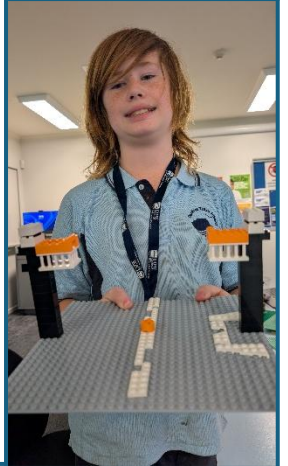
Our first **Kinder Transition** day is next Friday and we look forward to meeting and welcoming our newest students and their families.
