RONNY GIBBS NETBALL AND RUGBY LEAGUE 7'S GALA DAY



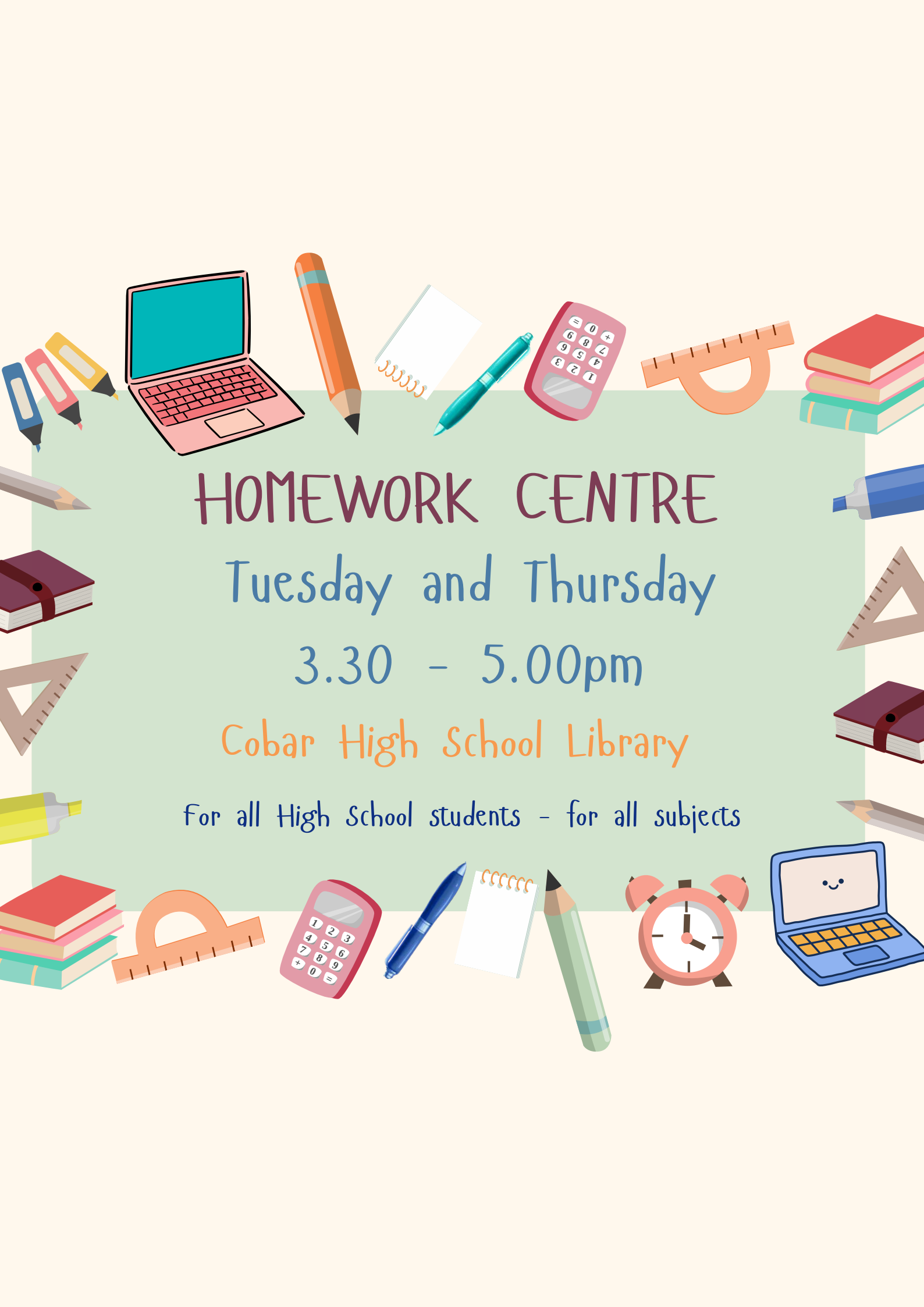
On Wednesday, 27th August, Cobar High School students proudly competed in the annual Ronny Gibbs Netball and Rugby League 7s Gala Day.

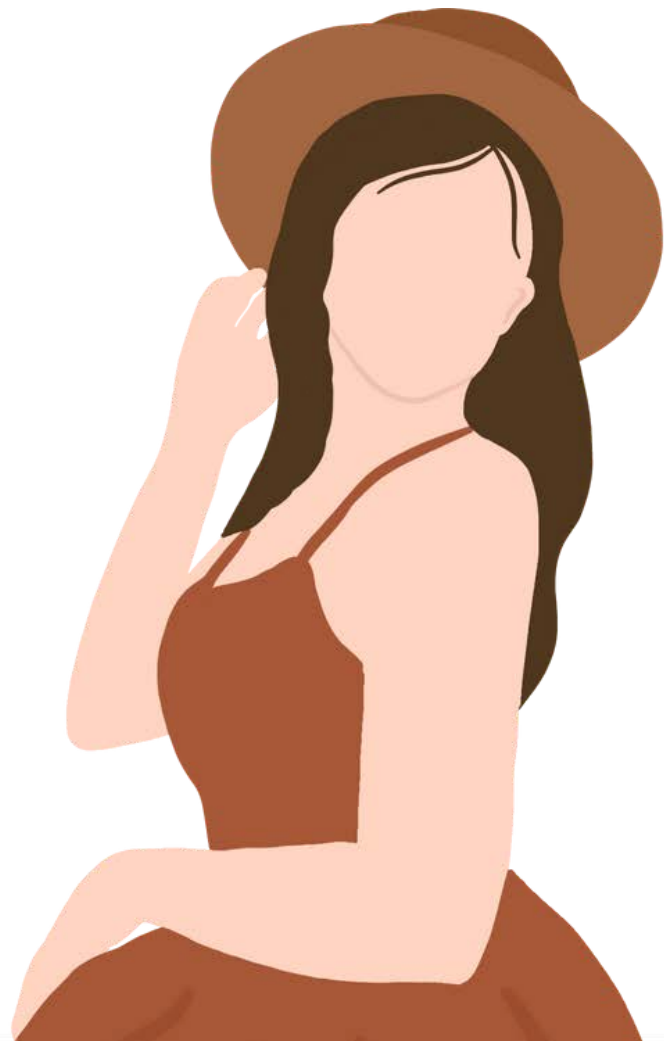
