Science

Dissecting chicken wings! This hands-on activity allows students to observe and understand how muscles, bones, tendons, and ligaments work together to produce movement.

By comparing the chicken wing to the human arm, students can identify key structures like the humerus, radius, ulna, biceps, and triceps.


They'll also explore how muscles contract and relax to move joints, and how tendons connect muscles to bones.

Through hands-on activities and engaging lessons, they're discovering how our lungs work to keep our bodies energised and healthy
















