Some students have even been lucky enough to receive a Canteen Reward Voucher! Ice blocks on these hot Summer days have been greatly enjoyed!


Milks are also still available to purchase in the mornings before school.

How to respond to an Absence Explanation SMS request.

- Open the parent portal link https://portal.schoolbytes.education/auth/login – and log in to your portal.
- 2. Select attendance from the navigation bar.
- 3. Select respond for the absence.
- 4. Select an absence type from the available options.
- 5. Optionally upload any supporting documentation.
- 6. Enter a reason for the absence in the comment field.
- 7. Select submit.

Once the school has reviewed and approved the absence, it will no longer appear in the absences list.
