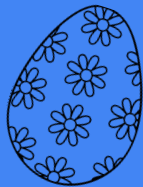


COMO WEST CONNECTION POINT

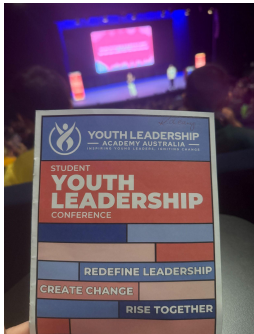

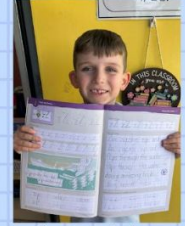

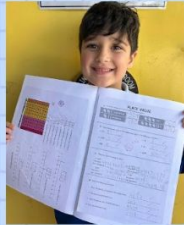
