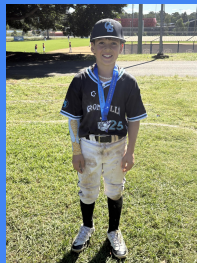
In recognition of World Autism Understanding Month, our students proudly wore yellow and gold and contributed a gold coin donation to support autism awareness, acceptance and Inclusion.

World Autism Awareness Month

This week at CWPS, students celebrated World Autism Understanding Month. Autism is a lifelong, neurodevelopmental condition that affects how a person thinks, feels, interacts with others and experiences their environment. In Australia, around 1 in 40 people are Autistic. World Autism Understanding Month focuses on building practical understanding of autism through Autistic perspectives, evidence and everyday experiences. The aim is to move beyond assumptions and support more informed, respectful interactions. Students learnt about the perspectives of people with Autism and engaged in activities to help them understand what everyday life is like for people with Autism.
