Coins for Jeans for Genes Day



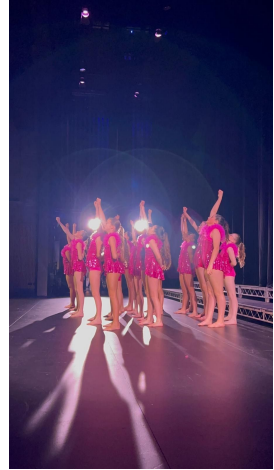
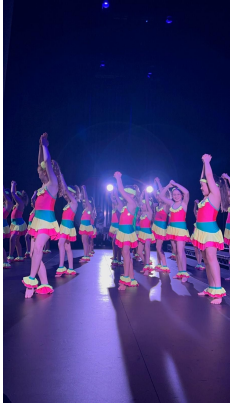
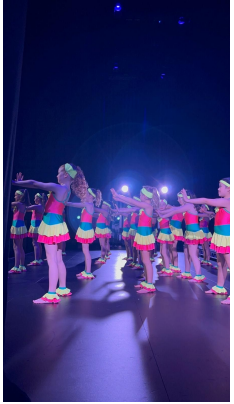
