Toys at school

Students who bring toys to school will be asked to leave them in their school bags during class time. This will help students concentrate on their learning without distractions, allowing them to fully engage in lessons and activities. When toys are present, they can lead to disruptions in the classroom, making it difficult for both teachers and students to maintain focus. Students sharing and playing with personal toys can lead to conflicts and disagreements among students and so students are reminded that they are only to play with their own toy in the playground and not take other students' toys to play with or share their toy with other students.

School wide expectations & reflection practices

Copmanhurst Public School has the following school-wide rules and expectations: Respectful, Safe, Learner. Our staff are committed to teaching and modelling positive behaviour and to supporting all students to be engaged with their learning. Teachers reward positive behaviour daily and weekly using several methods and use their discretion to know when students should reflect on their behaviours and will involve students in a reflective conversation to encourage problem solving about the situation. Reflective practice can be in the form of a conversation with the teacher or a 'Reflection Sheet' which should be signed and returned to school. This will support discussions at home about better choices that can be made next time. We appreciate your support in working with us.
