School Counsellor

The school counselling service supports students in a range of ways including cognitive assessments to identify specific learning needs and providing strategies for regulating emotions. Our counsellor visits one day per fortnight and parents can refer their child to the counsellor if they have concerns. Please let the school know if you would like your child to see the school counsellor.

Sickness & Attendance

As the colder months begin to set in, we understand that viruses and other sickness set in also. If your child is unwell, please keep them at home to stop the spread. Thankyou to everyone who is using the School Bytes app to promptly reply to messages regarding absences. When any absences are unexplained after two days, families will receive an email and/or letter to request that the absence reason is explained to the school. This process is so that we can reduce the number of unexplained absences which need to be reported and ensures that students are only taking time off school when they are sick or other leave is granted by the Principal. After 3 days of being absent, you may be requested to provide a medical certificate to justify the absence. Students are expected to attend school everyday unless they are unwell, or the leave reason is a justifiable reason for missing school.
