Rude, Mean, Bully or Conflict?



Examples:

- . Bad manners: not thanking someone when they help you
- Being inconsiderate: forming a circle and not making enough space for someone else to sit in there
- Thoughtless: taking the biggest piece of cake and not leaving enough for everyone else





Examples:

- . Saying something nasty about a person's appearance, speech, smell or clothing
- . Laughing at someone and not with them
- Telling people not to play or talk to someone



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Rude, Mean, Bullying or Conflict?

3 BULLYING = Bullying is when someone is trying to hurt you over and over again. It is a repeated act of unkindness.

. A person tells you that you are ugly. You tell them to stop but they do it again and again, at different moments in the school day, week or term

Bullying involves a power imbalance - that means that the person doing it has more power than you which makes it hard to stop

Bullving is not an accident, it is intentional. Someone is purposely trying to hurt you.



CONFLICT = An argument, a fight, a disagreement, a difference i opinion!
