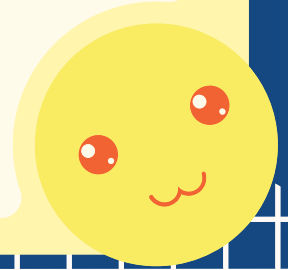

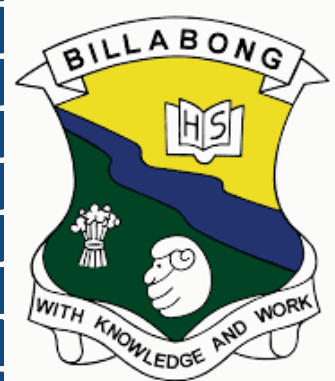

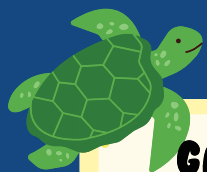
ASSEMBLY
