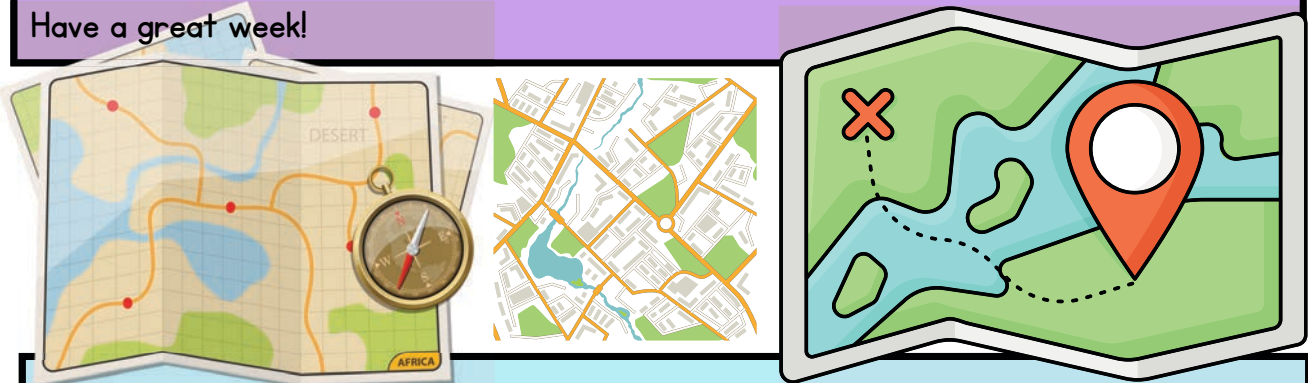


CLASS NEWS CONT.

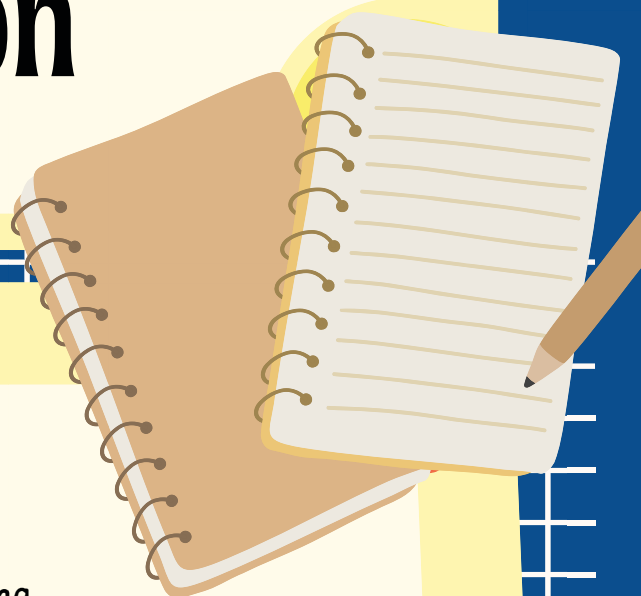
