From 1:20pm - 2:00pm - Lunch - Join us for a free sausage sizzle.


From 2:00pm - 3:00pm - Sporting Activities.


POSTPONEMENT ANNOUNCEMENT






CIASS NEWS


Click on the Interview Icon
