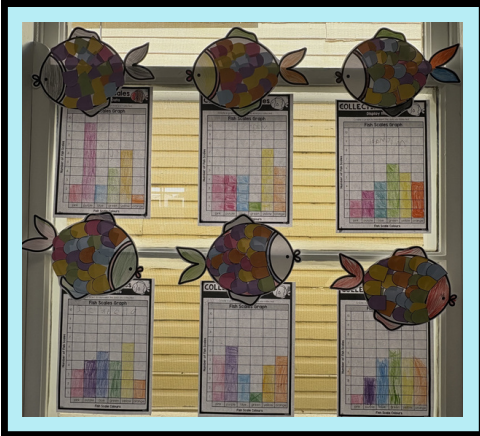
CLASS NEWS
