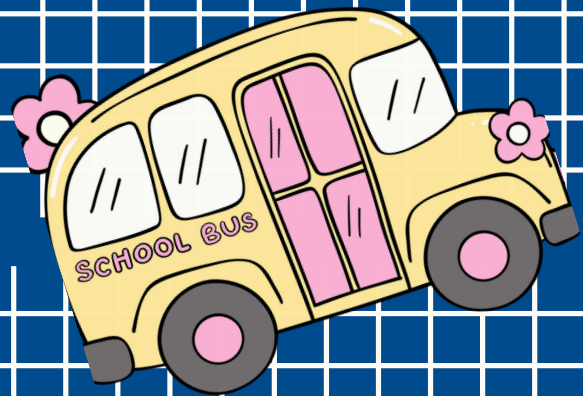

5-6 CLASS NEWS



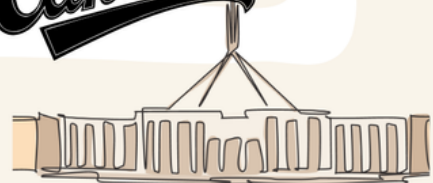
This week, 5/6 started a new novel study called Worse Things.
